2011 MOLAA Summer Art Camp Rules/Policies

Dear Parents,

To ensure that your child's experience is safe and enjoyable, the following rules and policies have been established. It is understood that by enrolling in MOLAA's Summer Art Camp, you and your child agree to adhere to these rules. Please read and sign below and submit it by the end of the first day of camp:

1. We request that all participants respect each other and treat one another as they would like to be treated.
2. Students agree to respect the instructors and counselors. Insubordination is condition for being sent home. If a camper breaks the rules, a time out will be enforced as a warning. If, after the time out the camper continues to misbehave, s/he will be removed from the camp setting and the parent/guardian will be asked to pick up her/his camper.
3. No telephones, electronic games or toys are allowed. Please leave all valuables at home, as we are not responsible for any items lost during camp. *If your child **must** carry a telephone, please note that mismanagement of the phone (playing games during instruction, etc.) warrants the phone being taken away from your child immediately.*
4. Please be sure to label all your camper's belongings clearly with your child's name. This includes lunch sacks and water bottles.
5. All campers must be picked up on time (5 p.m.). Drop off is not allowed until 8:55 a.m. Additional child care is available from 8-9 a.m. and 5- 6 p.m. for \$10 per hour. Late pick-ups (after 6 p.m.) will be charged \$50 per hour or the fraction of the hour.
6. After the first day of camp, no refunds will be given for withdrawal from the program.
7. If you must pick up your child early on a regular basis, please inform the instructor on the first day of camp so that your child is ready when you arrive.
8. If you arrive to pick up your child while camp is still in session, please check-in with the admissions desk and *do not disrupt the class in session*. We want campers to feel as if this is "their space" without disruptions from mom, dad, etc.
