### Trip Highlights – Seven nights and eight days

The trip will include 5 nights at the five star Parque Central Hotel in Havana and meals in the city's finest restaurants. We will have access to private performances, artist's studios, cultural centers, museums and all that this remarkable city has to offer. We will spend two days and nights outside of Havana in the city of Cienfuegos, the Pearl of the Caribbean. From there, will visit the colonial city of Trinidad, founded in 1514 and declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1988.

During the past year, **MOLAA** has had the extraordinary privilege to showcase several **Cuban artists**, mounting the first one person museum shows in the United States of both **Roberto Fabelo** and **Esterio Segura**. Currently, MOLAA is showing a collection of the iconic photographs of **Alberto Korda**; has acquired an important piece by the prominent and provocative artist, **José Toirac**; and will soon be installing a major gift to the museum, a monumental sculpture by Havana artist, **William Pérez**. This trip will provide very special access to many of the top contemporary artists living and working in Cuba today.
